# **Karting Terms and Conditions**

### Refunds:

Refunds will be given only if the RIDGE GRAND PRIX is shut down due to weather conditions prohibiting karting or at the discretion of Ridge management.

#### Online Reservations:

If booking online, please arrive 30 minutes prior to your reserved karting time to allow ample time for the check in process. If you do not arrive at least 30 minutes prior, you run the risk of missing your reserved slot which will result in the moving your party to the next available time.

If you cannot make your reservation, please notify the ridge and our staff will do our best to move you to another race session. Should you fail to notify the ridge that you intend to miss your scheduled reservation, no refund will be given.

#### **Dress Code:**

Closed-toe shoes are required to race, if you do not arrive with closed shoes, you run the risk of not racing. Long pants are recommended and individuals with long hair are advised to bring a hair tie. The Ridge is not responsible for injuries caused by racers wearing shorts, skirts, dresses, or other loose fabrics.

# Height/age Restriction:

Racers must be at least 5 ft tall and 15 years of age or older. Any minors intending to race must have a parent or legal guardian present to sign their release wavier.

## Safety:

Individuals who appear under the influence of drugs or alcohol will not be permitted to race; this will be determined at the discretion of Ridge employees. If this occurs, individuals will have the opportunity to reschedule their race. Racers who appear overly aggressive or who disregard the given safety debrief will be taken off the track and asked to sit out for the remainder of their scheduled race.

PLEASE BE AWARE THAT THE RIDGE GRAND PRIX GO KARTS CAN REACH SPEEDS OF 45+MPH AND THE TRACK CONTAINS 16 TURNS AND ELEVATION CHANGES THAT MAY BE PHYSICALLY DEMANDING AND/OR CHALLENGING TO SOME RACERS. IF YOU HAVE HEALTH CONDI-



PLEASE NOTE, racers whose speed does not match that of the racers around them will be pulled off the track due to safety concerns. Racers will be given a chance to correct their speed, however if racers continue to race at an unsafe speed, they will be removed from the race.
